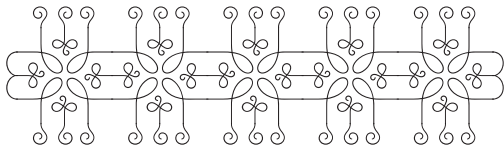


ROSETTA STONE



Isaiah was told to take a great tablet and write upon it. Writing on clay tablets was an ancient practice. The Rosetta Stone was a trilingual inscription (Egyptian hieroglyphic, Egyptian demotic, and Greek) that was the key to the decipherment of hieroglyphics. It contained a decree in honor of Ptolemy V, Epiphanes, voted by the priests of Egypt assembled at Memphis. It was written in 196 B.C. and discovered in 1799 at Rashid in the Egyptian delta. It is the type of tablet used by Isaiah.
