1. The Qualities of his Life:

1. He was full of faith. (a) Faith was the dynamic of his life. (b) Faith filled him with courage. (c) Faith filled him with a burning zeal. (d) Faith filled him with a deathless conviction.

2. He was full of the Holy Ghost. (a) He was charged with the power of God. He was completely given over to the direction of God. The world will hear from such a man:

1. If you put him in prison he can sing and pray the walls down. Acts 16:25-28

2. If he is dragged into court he can make the judge on the bench tremble and beg for more time. Acts 24:24-25

1. Before king Agrippa Acts 26:24-29.

3. If you kill him he will do more in his death than he did in a lifetime.
