THE CHARACTERS

- 1. There were those whose faces were cruel and hard. The Pharisees.
- 2. There was the face of "EXHIBIT A" the soiled rag of womanhood brought low by sin.
- 3. There was the face of Jesus ... strong and tender.

THE WOMAN

1. She was not only guilty, she had been caught in the act of shame. FALSE STANDARD: Not so bad to be guilty, but to be caught is awful. The found that it was not the closing in of night, but the downling of a new day

- THE PHARASEES 1. They were the keepers of the law and religious leaders of their day.
 - 2. The did not care about the woman, much less her sin, but simply used her to embarrass Jesus.

THEIR INDIFFERENCE TO THE WOMAN

- 1. They were as hard as nails ... and cold as icicles. 2. They did not involve her in this humiliating situation because they were indignant at her sin.
- 3. It was not because they were seeking by her punishment to build a cleaner and better community.
- 4. They were not seeing by bringing her to Jesus to do her Anyreal good.

STONE HER OR NOT STONE HER Sev. 20:10; Deaf. 22:22

- I. Jesus knew what the law was and he knew they knew. 2. Jesus gave no immediate answer ... but stooped and
- wrote on the ground. Their continued inquiry. 3. Jesus wrote on the ground the second time.

WHY DID JESUS WRITE ON THE GROUND ... WHAT DID HE WRITE?

- 1. He may have been ashemed of these religious leaders. 2. May be he was trying to spare this unfortunate woman.
- TWO TYPES OF SIN SHOW UP HERE
 - 1. Sins of the flesh. This was her sin.
 - 2. Sins of disposition. Their sin. Elder Son: Luke 15:11 3. Throwing stones with our hands or our tongues never in order. Congratulate our selves for speaking mind.
