1. Tongues of men and of angels.

A loveless exhibition of oratory
that men might pronounce angelic.

3. Counterfeit Enthusiasm. 1 Cor. 13:2

1. Mysteries at once understood.

2. All knowledge available. Mountains
removed by faith. ~~Mysteries and
mountains cannot retard the love-
less spirit's prayer.~~

4. Counterfeit Martyrdoms. 1 Cor. 13:3.

1. I bestow all my goods to feed the
poor. I give my body to be burned
and yet because love is wanting

in such cases, they constitute an un-
acceptable and profitless service.

5. God never grants a manifestation,
but that Satan gets up through self-
confident men a counterfeit.
