2 Cor. 11:28; Acts 20:17-21; Rom. 1:14-16

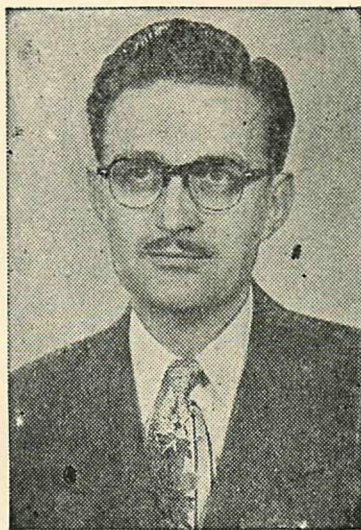
If you really care about the church you will:
