 1. Solomon tried everything and did not find happiness in them. Eccl. 12:8, 13
4. Happiness and contentment not found in position and fame.
 1. Many spent their time climbing the social ladder... trampled underfoot the good.
5. Happiness and contentment not found in military glory.
 1. Alexander the Great conquered the whole world. Died at the age of 33 years because he could not conquer his own lusts
