Impossibility: Noun.

1. Impossible: Old French to Latin to the English.
  1. Definition: Not possible; incapable of being or of occurring. Utterly impracticable or hopeless; with out chance.

  1. It is impossible for God to lie. Hebrews 6:17,18. He cannot lie because he is truth absolute; John 14:6; He cannot deny himself; 2 Tim. 2:13.
  2. It is impossible to neglect salvation and be saved. Hebrews 2:3.
  3. It is impossible to be saved without the shedding of blood. Hebrews 9:22.
  4. It is impossible to believe in Christ and obey him and not be saved. Mark 16:15-16.
  5. It is impossible to enter into the kingdom except through Christ. John 14:6.
  6. It is impossible to enter heaven without a birth of water and the Spirit. John 3:3,5
  7. It is impossible to be saved without faith in Christ. Hebrews 11:6.
