Acts 10:24; James 2:23.

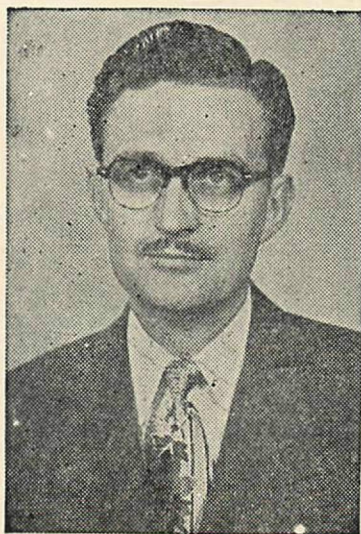
1. Be Happy yourself.
