1-We hear people spoken of as:

1-Good souls.

2-Poor souls, and the like; but let us now think of those who may be called "Little Souls"

2-The old fashioned garden:

1-It was, and is now, the custom in old-fashion gardens to cut back the shrubs and trees, which were intended by nature to grow large and luxuriant, till they become stunted and dwarfed, even grotesque.
