

MY PEOPLE DOETH NOT CONSIDER. Isaiah 1:3

1. We should cultivate the habit of considering the issues of various courses of conduct. We should regard our:

1. Thoughts; words; action; as the farmer regards his seeds--as the germs of a Gal. 6:7-8; ~~ROMAN~~ future harvest. Rom. 6:12; 1; Rom. 2:6-11.

2. "My people doeth not consider."

To consider is:

1. Think deliberately, to reflect maturely.

3. We SHOULD CONSIDER:

1. The character and will of God.

He is great wise, powerful, holy, and just. Not willing that any should perish. 2 Pet. 3:9.

2. Ourselves. Our spiritual state before God. Is it one of:

1. Ignorance, or of knowledge. Hosea 4:6
Romans 10:1-3; 1 Cor. 15:34.

3. The importance of life. Life is the seed time for eternity.

1. Life is a sowing and a reaping.

Low Work Hosea 8:7; 10:12; 2 Cor. 9:6; Lu. 6:38.

4. The Solemnities of death. Consider: *JUST*

1. Its certainty. Heb. 9:27; Gen. 3:19. Deut. 32:29.
