

"Notes on Romans 12:10"

- 1-Let love of the brethren be tenderly affectioned one to another.
  - 1-Christians must cultivate the feelings of kindly affection one to another in a true spirit of brotherly love.
  - 2-Hebrews 13:1;  
Let brotherly love continue.
  - 3-1-Peter 1:22;  
Love one another with a pure heart fervently.
  
- 2-This duty may be regarded as the badge of discipleship.
  - 1-By this shall all men know that ye are my disciple, if ye love one another. John 13:35.
  - 2-Man, Officers, carry badges to prove their identity.
  
- 3-The greek word,  $\phi\lambda\lambda\omicron\sigma\tau\omicron\pi\omicron\varsigma$ , which we translate kindly affectioned signifies:
  - 1-That tender and indescribable affection which a mother bears to her baby. Signifies a delight in it.
  - 2-So paul said, "Feel the tenderest affection toward one another, and delight to feel it.
  - 3-The use here indicates that the church tie should rival that of the family. Love a brother Christian with the affection of a natural brother.

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2- The Greek word ἀγαπᾷν, which we translate kindly affectioned signifies:

1- Tender and indissoluble affection which a mother bears to her baby. Σιχαίνα a delight in
