The principle that comes out in these words is one that will sweep the whole circle of worship including:

1. Work; 2. Gifts; 3. Personal religious life.

1. WORK: Not to scheme only that are pleasant and in times that are convenient.

2. Gifts: Not with careless gifts, almost covertly given, or the smallest coin dealt out niggardly or parsimoniously.

3. Personal religious life. There is ingratitude in the spirit that relegates all religious care to:

1. The leisure of Sunday.
2. Or of the sick room,
3. Or of the infirmities of old age.

Matthew 2:11

1. The wise men from the east. Matt. 2:1. The three stages in their approach to God.

1. Vision: They say his star and came.

2. Submission: They feel down.

3. Consecration: Worshipped him.

2. They worshipped him. Verse 11, Matt. 2

1. They presented themselves; 2. A living sacrifice; 3. A reasonable service. *Rom. 12:1*
