

1. The Prophet's Plea

1. Every person on earth is a traveller.
2. Eternity is the termination of the journey
3. THE TRAGEDY:
 1. Too many are thinking only of the way in which they travel and are not considering the end of the way.

2. THE WAY SPECIFIED

1. It is a revealed way.
 - (1) It is not the way of personal feeling.
 - (2) It is not the way of one's parents.
2. It is a way of faith.
 - (1) Too many say, "I do not see why..."
 - (2) We walk by faith. 2 Cor.5:7.
 - (3) It is an obedient faith. Heb.11:8.

3. THE WAY DESCRIBED

1. It is the old way. "ask for the oldpaths"
 - (1) It is older than my father and mother.
 - (2) It is older than the reformation movement.
 - (3) It is older than the restoration movement.
2. It is the good way. "...where is the good way."
 - (1) Any religious practice should be questioned: "Is it from heaven or from men?" Matthew 21:23-27.

4. THE PROPHET'S PLEAS CONCERNING THE WAY.

1. He urges solemn consideration. "Stand in the ways and see."
2. He pleads for serious inquiry: "Ask for the old paths."
