

SINS THAT CRUCIFIED CHRIST

INTRODUCTION: Matt. 27:23-31

1. Every one condemns all who took part in the crucifixion.
2. All condemn the sins that led up to the crucifixion.
3. To be consistent one must condemn the same sins today.

WHAT WERE THOSE SINS?

1. THE SIN OF IGNORANCE.

1. On the cross Jesus prayed, "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." Lk. 23:34
2. Peter said, "Brethren, I know that in ignorance ye did it, as did also your rulers." Acts 3:17
3. This sin of ignorance is with us today:
 1. People should know the New Testament church
 2. They should know the simple plan of salvation.

2. THE SIN OF HATRED OF GOOD.

1. In Acts 10:38 Peter spoke of Jesus as one "who went about doing good..."
2. In John 3:19 Jesus said, "...and men loved darkness, rather than light, because their deeds were evil." John 15:25; Jesus said, "...They hated me without a cause."
 1. Evil has every fought against and attempted to destroy that which is good.
 2. Evil is still opposed to good and error to truth.
 3. Let us condemn the hatred that would destroy good and the error that would destroy truth.

3. THE SIN OF ENVY.

1. Matt. 27:18; "For he knew that for envy they had delivered him up. Envy does a lot of wrong things. Acts 7:9; "And the patriarchs moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him."
 1. The sin of envy has cursed every generation down through the ages.

4. THE SIN OF RELIGIOUS PREJUDICE.

1. Those who crucified Christ were religious people. Matt. 15:9; "But in vain do they worship me teaching for doctrines commandments of men."

5. THE SIN OF LYING.

1. Matt. 26:59-61; 59-Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death; 60-But found none: yea, thought many false witnesses came, yet they found none. At last came two false witnesses, 61- And said, this fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days."
(See John 2:18-22)

2. The sin of lying has cursed man to this time. 1 Kings 13:18.
Let us condemn the sin of lying wherever it is found.

6. THE SIN OF THE LOVE OF MONEY.

1. Judas betrayed Jesus for thirty pieces of silver. Matt. 26:15, 16
2. The love of money is the root of all kinds of evil. 1 Tim 6:10
3. Judas betrayed the earthly body of Jesus for thirty pieces of silver. HOW AWFUL WE SAY!
4. What people do today:
 1. Some church members betray his spiritual body for money today; Some betray it for pleasure; Some for power.
 2. To be consistent we must condemn this sin everywhere.

7. THE SIN OR MORAL WEAKNESS.

1. Pilate knew that Jesus was innocent. Lk.23:13F
2. Yet he bowed to the wishes of the people. Luke 23:20, 24
3. Many know today what they should do in obedience to God, but they are not strong enough to do it.

Let us condemn the sin of moral weakness by encouraging people to repent and be strong enough to overcome for the Lord. Do you have the courage to repent and be baptized in to Christ?

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
