1. The Christian's attitude toward his fellows makes him a good citizen.
  - a. Attitude of tolerance. 1 Cor. 9:22
    1. I complied with their customs:  
Dress, habits, manner of life,  
food. If truth offends we cannot help that.
  - b. His attitude toward wealth.
    1. He remembers the words of Jesus Mark 8:36,37. Remembering these words make him:
      - a. Less avaricious; less greedy  
Less disposed to hoard up.  
Luke 12:13-21.
  - c. His attitude toward mercy. *Michah 5:8*
    1. He lives in view of judgment:  
Gal. 6;7; 2 Cor. 9:6. Matt. 5:7
    2. His view of Benevolence is broader and more genuine than that of the world. Mat. 5:47, Gal. 6:10. See John 9:4.
2. The Christians attitude toward his government makes him a good citizen.
  - a. The government his friend.  
Rom. ~~13~~ 13:1-4.
  - b. He supports his government.  
Luke 20:20-25; Rom. 13:5-7.
