

Acts 3*The Common Error of Humanity Acts 14:8-18
1:10)

1-Romans 8:6-8: These verses teach that:

1-Man in his earthly state is dually minded-

1-Partly carnal, and partly spiritual.

2-That the carnal mind is subject to the laws of the flesh, and cannot be subject to the laws of God.

3-That the spiritual mind is subject to the laws of God.

4-That man, while in the flesh, can not be altogether spiritually minded.

5-The carnal mind is not subject to the law of God. It can not be. It would do no good to preach the Gospel to a horse.

6-If it were possible for a man to be altogether

1-Carnally minded, or totally depraved, he would be a mere brute, incapable of regen.

2-The spiritual mind can hear; {Acts 16:31.

1-Understand and obey the gospel; {Acts 2:37-38}

3-Those who obey the gospel:

1-Romans 6:17-But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. 18:That form of

doctrine was, baptism which symbolizes the:

1-Death; 2-Burial and resurrection of Christ

Rom.6:18-Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness

4-There is but one way of ascertaining whether or not those who have been baptized have really been born again: John 3:3; teaches that one must be born again. Matt.7:20; by their fruits ye shall know them. 1-Gal.5:19-24.... (Their works will indicate whether or not they can be called "Christians".....

5-The common error of humanity is, therefore, that of putting a literal, or material, construction upon spiritual teaching.
