1-The Journey Of Life:

1-Commences at baptism: Col.3:1-2;

If ye then be risen with Christ seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. (2)-Set your affections on things above, not on things of the earth.

2-The Journey is continued by going on toward perfection. Heb.6:1;
