"The Storm" Mark 4:35-41; Lk:8:22-25; Mt.8:23 1-The scene: 1-The Sea of Galilee: Northern part of Palestine Oval shaped; about 13 miles long and six wide. 2-2-The scene here depicted seems to be an emblem of the condition, of the needs, of the fears. of the Church of Christ and certainly does set forth the: 1-The perpetual presence ---- The brotherly care ... and the Divine dignity of the Lord Jeaus Christ 3-The contrast: 1-The disciples were on the sea of Galilee: 2-We are upon the sea of life of this uncertain world. 1-They took Christ with them in the boat. 2-We have him with us always. 1-A storm arose and threatened their safety. 2-In this world we are exposed to the tempest of trials, doubt, and danger. 4-There are two questions in the record which represent the two movements of the narrative. 1-The question of the disciples, "Hast thou no care" 2-It was the cry of impulse, and a cry which has often sprung from the heart of the Lord's people in their griefs and dangers. 1-It was a cry of fear: 1-Christians have the same natural passions as other men. 2-In times of bodily danger. 3-In scenes of public commotion and disaster 4-In circumstances of threating and suffering to the Church, the fears of Christ's people have often been awakened and we cry "Carest thou not that we perish" 2-It was a cry evincing some faith. 1-They called unto him, entreated him to save them. 3-A cry evincing some defect in faith.
