

"THE VOYAGE OF LIFE" Acts 27:1-44.

1. There seems to be a close analogy between the course of a man's life through the world, from his birth to his grave, and the progress of a ship from his birth to his grave.
2. The journey which is described in the 27th chapter may suggest to us some of the main features of the long voyage of our life.

1. The variety in our companionship as in this instance:

1. The captain, Sailors, Soldiers, prisoners, and above all.....
LUKE, PAUL, ARISTARCHUS.

Continuance, endure, wait, waiting

2. The need for labor and for patience.⁴³

1. John 9:4...I must work said Jesus.

2. John 4:34..."My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work."

3. John 9:3...Neither hath this man sinned nor his parents.

4. Labor and patience are the two oars which will bring the boat to shore in the *daily* day passage of life.

3. There is an occasional demand for sacrifice: WHAT THESE MEN DID.
