NOTE:

1. "I cannot" never accomplished anything
2. "I will try" has wrought wonders

1. The resolution is not, THIS WILL I TRY TO DO.

Prov. 3:1-6

Jer. 43:2(a) If we believe a thing to be impossible we have made up our minds to fail.
Acts 16:9

2. The resolution is not, THIS I WISH I COULD DO.

(A) Wishing is not an element of strength!

A sort of day dreaming that actually weakens. *The block of granite which is an obstacle in the pathway of the weak becomes a stepping stone in the pathway of the strong*

THIS WILL I DO; Examples,

1. Joshua was uncertain about Israel but he knew what he was going to do. Josh. 24:15

2. The case of the rich fool and his bursting barns. What shall I do? Purpose; planning; This will I do: Luke 12:16-21

Having no higher wisdom he is a fool
3. The case of the unjust steward. 20K 16:1-12
His question: What shall I do?
His answer: I am resolved what to do...

4. The case of the prodigal son. He came to himself... I will arise and go to my father... Luke 15:11-32.

5. Consider your own case.

(a) What shall I do? Serve the gods of this world....

(b) This will I do, Or turn and become a faithful servant of God.
