TWO WAYS IN WHICH ONE MAY WALK:

1. Man's ways. Proverbs 14:12.  
(1) Man's way not safe. 1 Cor. 3:3.
2. God's way. Psalms 18:30  
(1) God's Way characterized by simplicity  
Isaiah 35:8.

EXAMPLES OF MEN WHO WALKED WITH GOD:

1. Enoch walked with God. Gen.5:21-24; Heb.11:5.
2. Noah walked with God. Gen.6:9; Heb.11:7.

WHAT IT MEANS TO WALK WITH GOD:

1. We must walk in newness of life. Romans 6:4.  
2 Cor.5:17  
Eph. 4:22,24
2. We must walk by faith. Rom.8:24,25;  
2 Cor.5:7; Heb.11:1
3. We must walk worthily. Eph. 4:1-3; Col.1:10
4. We must walk in love. John 15:9,10; Rom.13:8
5. Walking with God means to press on. There can be no letting up in the battle.
