(Do not go to extreme on 'conscience', Rom. 14) *v 5 23*
must be educated conscience

2. Will it lead to intemperance?

Nab. 2:5

3. Will it influence others to sin? Test of a Christian—consider the weak. *Rom 14:15*

4. Will it offend a brother?

Rom 14:17-21

5. Will it place me in a false ~~light~~ light or desecrate the church? Abstain from the appearance of evil. *1 Thess. 5:22*

6. Can I ask God to be with me in it?

7. Will it help others?

Work out your own salvation, decision only you can make. Sins based on selfishness. Seek the other man's good.
