REASONS WHY SOME MEN LIVE:

1. Some men live for money.

A. For a while it is his, then he departs and leaves it to his heirs. From him it is forever gone.

B. The Bible teaches:

- Matt. 13:22* A. Rich cannot be saved. Mk. 10:24  
b. Money can destroy. 1 Tim. 6:8-10  
c. We cannot take our money with us. 1 Tim. 6:7.

2. Some men live for fame.

A. A few days he is praised by his fellows.

B. In a short time the echo of the praise fades away into the realms of eternal silence.

3. Some men live for power.

A. Ere long the scepter falls from his cold fingers and he is forgot.

4. Some Men live for pleasure.

A. Presently the roses wither, the lights are dimmed, and the dregs of the cup become bitter.

A. Build upon the rock and your building will stand. Matt. 7:24-27.

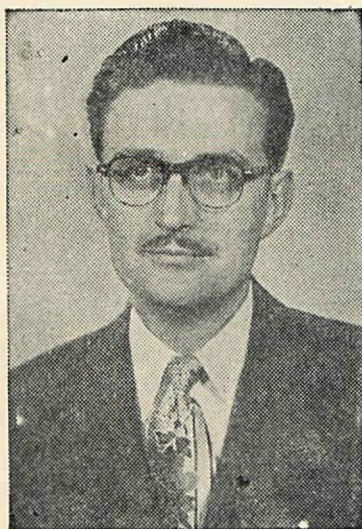
B. To build upon the rock is the whole duty of man. Eccl. 12:1, 13, 14
