1. Vain worship. Matt. 15:9;

Empty devoid of real value

2. Ignorant Worship. Acts 17:23.

Destitute of knowledge
1. Paul in Athens. The confusion
of Polytheism. *Reverence and*
reverentia
The worshippers
can never be sure they have
propitiated the right god.

2. The restfulness of Monotheism.
