1 Corinthians 1:1-17

Key Words for Lesson 2

¹ Paul, <u>called</u> to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and <u>Sosthenes</u> our brother,

- ³ **Grace** be unto you, and **peace**, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- ⁴ I thank my God <u>always</u> on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ; ⁵ That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all <u>utterance</u>, and *in* all <u>knowledge</u>; ⁶ Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you:
- ⁷ So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: ⁸ Who shall also **confirm** you unto the end, *that ye may be* **blameless** in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ **God** *is* **faithful**, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.
- ¹⁰ Now I beseech you, <u>brethren</u>, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all <u>speak the same thing</u>, and *that* there be no divisions among you; but *that* ye be <u>perfectly joined together</u> in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- ¹¹ For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them *which* are of the house of <u>Chloe</u>, that there are contentions among you. ¹² Now this I say, that every one of you saith, <u>I am of Paul</u>; and <u>I of Apollos</u>; and <u>I of Christ</u>.
- 13 <u>Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?</u>
- ¹⁴ I thank God that I baptized none of you, but <u>Crispus</u> and <u>Gaius</u>; ¹⁵ Lest any should say that I had baptized in mine own name. ¹⁶ And I baptized also the household of Stephanas: besides, <u>I know not</u> whether I baptized any other. ¹⁷ <u>For Christ sent me not to baptize</u>, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.
