3. Four Facts to remember about the goodness of God.
 1. God gives only good gifts.
 2. The way God gives is good.
 3. God gives constantly.
 4. God does not change.

4. God's greatest gift – a new birth.

 1. Receive the Word of God. vv. 19-21.
 2. Practice the Word of God. vv. 22-25.
