1. By their friendly attachment. 1 John 2:10; 3:14; 2 Cor. 13:10

2. By their active gratitude. Luke 21:1-4; 2 Cor. 8:1-5.

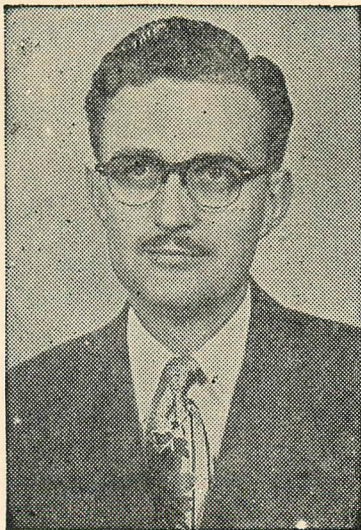
3. It brings us nearer to God.
