1. at the Cross. (REPENTANCE) 1. John 12:32

- 2. Rom. 6:6; "Knowing this that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed; that henceforth, we should not serve sin." 3. Gal. 2:20; "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless
 - I live; yet, not I, but Christ liveth in me..."
- 2. IN THE TOMB.
 - 1. Christ died and was buried in Joseph's new tomb.
 - 2. All who have met Christ at the cross (repented) must meet Christ in the tomb.
 - 1. After men die to sin (repent) they must be buried and raised with him.
 - 2. This done by being baptized: Acts 2:38; Rom. 6:4.
- 3. WE MUST MEET JESUS AROUND THE LORD'S TABLE 1. Matthew 26:26-29
- 4. WE MUST KEEP OUR APPOINTMENT WITH HIM IN THE DARK VALLEY

1. Out of the darkness of death itself we can hear these words: <u>Psalms 2 3:4</u> "Yea, though I walk through the June 12:5 valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me."
