Return #1: 539 BC
This return followed the decree of Cyrus in Ezra 1:2-4. The leaders were Sheshbazzar, Zerubbabel, and Jeshua. The temple was completed in 516 BC.

Return #2: 458 BC
Artaxerxes' decree in Ezra 7 gave Ezra approval to rebuild the city.

Return #3: 445 BC
Artaxerxes allowed his cup bearer, Nehemiah, to return and rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
