

ROMANS LESSON 10

SELECTED VERSES ABOUT GRACE & FAITH

- (1) **John 1:17** — **Grace** and truth came through Jesus Christ.
- (2) **Acts 15:11** — We will be saved through the **grace** of the Lord Jesus.
- (3) **Acts 18:27** — He greatly helped those who through **grace** had believed.
- (4) **Romans 3:24** — Justified by his **grace** as a gift.
- (5) **Romans 4:16** — That is why it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on **grace**.
- (6) **Romans 5:2** — Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this **grace** in which we stand.
- (7) **Romans 6:1** — Are we to continue in sin that **grace** may abound?
- (8) **Romans 6:14** — You are not under law but under **grace**.
- (9) **Romans 11:5** — There is a remnant, chosen by **grace**.
- (10) **Romans 11:6** — But if it is by **grace**, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise **grace** would no longer be **grace**.
- (11) **2 Corinthians 6:1** — We appeal to you not to receive the **grace** of God in vain.
- (12) **2 Corinthians 8:9** — For you know the **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor.
- (13) **Galatians 5:4** — You have fallen away from **grace**.
- (14) **Ephesians 2:8** — For by **grace** you have been saved through faith.
- (15) **Ephesians 4:7** — But **grace** was given to each one of us according to the measure of Christ's gift.
- (16) **Colossians 1:6** — Since the day you heard it and understood the **grace** of God in truth.
- (17) **2 Thessalonians 2:16** — Who loved us and gave us eternal comfort and good hope through **grace**.
- (18) **2 Timothy 1:9** — Because of his own purpose and **grace**, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began.
- (19) **2 Timothy 2:1** — Be strengthened by the **grace** that is in Christ Jesus.
- (20) **Titus 2:11** — For the **grace** of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people.
- (21) **Titus 3:7** — Being justified by his **grace** we might become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
- (22) **Hebrews 2:9** — So that by the **grace** of God he might taste death for everyone.
- (23) **Hebrews 12:15** — See to it that no one fails to obtain the **grace** of God.
- (24) **James 4:6** — But he gives more **grace**. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives **grace** to the humble."
- (25) **2 Peter 3:18** — But grow in the **grace** and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
- (1) **Matthew 14:31** — O you of little **faith**, why did you doubt?
- (2) **Matthew 17:20** — If you have **faith** like a grain of mustard seed ... nothing will be impossible for you.
- (3) **Matthew 21:22** — And whatever you ask in prayer, you will receive, if you have **faith**.
- (4) **Mark 2:5** — And when Jesus saw their **faith**.
- (5) **Mark 4:40** — Why are you so afraid? Have you still no **faith**?
- (6) **Luke 22:32** — But I have prayed for you that your **faith** may not fail.
- (7) **Acts 6:7** — And a great many of the priests became obedient to the **faith**.
- (8) **Acts 13:8** — But Elymas ... opposed them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the **faith**.
- (9) **Acts 14:22** — Encouraging them to continue in the **faith**.
- (10) **Acts 15:9** — Having cleansed their hearts by **faith**.
- (11) **Acts 16:5** — So the churches were strengthened in the **faith**.
- (12) **Romans 1:12** — That we may be mutually encouraged by each other's **faith**.
- (13) **Romans 1:17** — For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from **faith** for **faith**, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by **faith**."
- (14) **Romans 3:27** — By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of **faith**.
- (15) **Romans 3:28** — For we hold that one is justified by **faith** apart from works of the law.
- (16) **Romans 4:5** — And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his **faith** is counted as righteousness.
- (17) **Romans 9:30** — Gentiles who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by **faith**.
- (18) **Romans 10:17** — So **faith** comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.
- (19) **Romans 11:20** — But you stand fast through **faith**.
- (20) **Romans 14:23** — For whatever does not proceed from **faith** is sin.
- (21) **1 Corinthians 2:5** — That your **faith** might not rest in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.
- (22) **1 Corinthians 13:13** — So now **faith**, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.
- (23) **1 Corinthians 15:17** — And if Christ has not been raised, your **faith** is futile and you are still in your sins.
- (24) **1 Corinthians 16:13** — Be watchful, stand firm in the **faith**, act like men, be strong.
- (25) **2 Corinthians 5:7** — For we walk by **faith**, not by sight.
- (26) **2 Corinthians 13:5** — Examine yourselves, to see whether you are in the **faith**.
- (27) **Galatians 2:16** — We know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through **faith** in Jesus Christ.
- (28) **Galatians 3:7** — Know then that it is those of **faith** who are the sons of Abraham.
- (29) **Galatians 5:6** — But only **faith** working through love.
- (30) **Ephesians 2:8** — For by grace you have been saved through **faith**.
- (31) **Ephesians 3:12** — In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our **faith** in him.
- (32) **Ephesians 4:5** — One Lord, one **faith**, one baptism.
- (33) **Philippians 1:27** — With one mind striving side by side for the **faith** of the gospel.
- (34) **Colossians 2:12** — Having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through **faith**.
- (35) **1 Thessalonians 5:8** — Having put on the breastplate of **faith** and love.
- (36) **2 Thessalonians 1:4** — For your steadfastness and **faith** in all your persecutions.
- (37) **1 Timothy 1:19** — Some have made shipwreck of their **faith**.
- (38) **1 Timothy 3:9** — They must hold the mystery of the **faith** with a clear conscience.
- (39) **1 Timothy 4:1** — Some will depart from the **faith**.
- (40) **1 Timothy 6:12** — Fight the good fight of the **faith**.
- (41) **2 Timothy 3:15** — The sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through **faith** in Christ Jesus.
- (42) **Hebrews 11:1** — Now **faith** is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
- (43) **Hebrews 11:6** — And without **faith** it is impossible to please him.
- (44) **Hebrews 12:2** — Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our **faith**.
- (45) **James 1:3** — The testing of your **faith** produces steadfastness.
- (46) **James 2:24** — A person is justified by works and not by **faith** alone.
- (47) **James 2:26** — **Faith** apart from works is dead.
- (48) **1 Peter 1:5** — Guarded through **faith** for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
- (49) **1 John 5:4** — This is the victory that has overcome the world — our **faith**.
- (50) **Jude 1:3** — Contend for the **faith** that was once for all delivered to the saints.
