

ROMANS LESSON 18

THE WORD “TRUTH” IN PAUL’S EPISTLES

► **Romans 1:18** — For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the **truth**.

► **Romans 1:25** — Because they exchanged the **truth** about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.

► **Romans 2:8** — But for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the **truth**, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.

► **Romans 2:20** — An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of children, having in the law the embodiment of knowledge and **truth**—

► **Romans 3:7** — But if through my lie God’s **truth** abounds to his glory, why am I still being condemned as a sinner?

► **Romans 9:1** — I am speaking the **truth** in Christ—I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit—

► **1 Corinthians 5:8** — Let us therefore celebrate the festival, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and **truth**.

► **1 Corinthians 13:6** — It does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the **truth**.

► **2 Corinthians 4:2** — But we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God’s word, but by the open statement of the **truth** we would commend ourselves to everyone’s conscience in the sight of God.

► **2 Corinthians 11:10** — As the **truth** of Christ is in me, this boasting of mine will not be silenced in the regions of Achaia.

► **2 Corinthians 12:6** — Though if I should wish to boast, I would not be a fool, for I would be speaking the **truth**; but I refrain from it, so that no one may think more of me than he sees in me or hears from me.

► **2 Corinthians 13:8** — For we cannot do anything against the **truth**, but only for the **truth**.

► **Galatians 2:5** — To them we did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the **truth** of the gospel might be preserved for you.

► **Galatians 2:14** — But when I saw that their conduct was not in step with the **truth** of the gospel, I said to Cephas before them all, “If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?”

► **Galatians 4:16** — Have I then become your enemy by telling you the **truth**?

► **Galatians 5:7** — You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the **truth**?

► **Ephesians 1:13** — In him you also, when you heard the word of **truth**, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit.

► **Ephesians 4:15** — Rather, speaking the **truth** in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ.

► **Ephesians 4:21** — Assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the **truth** is in Jesus.

► **Ephesians 4:25** — Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the **truth** with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.

► **Ephesians 6:14** — Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of **truth**, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness.

► **Philippians 1:18** — What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in **truth**, Christ is proclaimed, and in that I rejoice. Yes, and I will rejoice.

► **Colossians 1:5-6** — Because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the **truth**, the gospel, which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing—as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in **truth**.

► **2 Thessalonians 2:10** — And with all wicked deception for those who are perish- ing, because they refused to love the **truth** and so be saved.

► **2 Thessalonians 2:12-13** — In order that all may be condemned who did not believe the **truth** but had pleasure in unrighteousness. But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the

firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the **truth**.

► **1 Timothy 2:4** — Who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the **truth**.

► **1 Timothy 2:7** — For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the **truth**, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and **truth**.

► **1 Timothy 3:15** — If I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the **truth**.

► **1 Timothy 4:3** — Who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods that God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the **truth**.

► **1 Timothy 6:5** — And constant friction among people who are depraved in mind and deprived of the **truth**, imagining that godliness is a means of gain.

► **2 Timothy 2:15** — Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of **truth**.

► **2 Timothy 2:18** — Who have swerved from the **truth**, saying that the resurrection has already happened. They are upsetting the faith of some.

► **2 Timothy 2:25** — Correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the **truth**.

► **2 Timothy 3:7-8** — Always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the **truth**. Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the **truth**, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith.

► **2 Timothy 4:4** — And will turn away from listening to the **truth** and wander off into myths.

► **Titus 1:1** — Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God’s elect and their knowledge of the **truth**, which accords with godliness.

► **Titus 1:14** — Not devoting themselves to Jewish myths and the commands of people who turn away from the **truth**.
