

Romans Lesson 42

“As a **seal** of the righteousness”

Matthew 27:66 — So they went and made the tomb secure by **sealing** the stone and setting a guard.

John 3:33 — Whoever receives his testimony sets his **seal** to this, that God is true.

John 6:27 — Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his **seal**.”

Romans 4:11 — He received the sign of circumcision as a **seal** of the righteousness that he had by faith while he was still uncircumcised. The purpose was to make him the father of all who believe without being circumcised, so that righteousness would be counted to them as well.

1 Corinthians 9:2 — If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you, for you are the **seal** of my apostleship in the Lord.

2 Corinthians 1:22 — And who has also put his **seal** on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

Ephesians 1:13 — In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were **sealed** with the promised Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 4:30 — And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were **sealed** for the day of redemption.

2 Timothy 2:19 — But God's firm foundation stands, bearing this **seal**: “The Lord knows those who are his,” and, “Let everyone who names the name of the Lord depart from iniquity.”

Revelation 5:1-2 — Then I saw in the right hand of him who was seated on

the throne a scroll written within and on the back, **sealed** with seven **seals**. And I saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice, “Who is worthy to open the scroll and break its **seals**?”

Revelation 5:5 — And one of the elders said to me, “Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven **seals**.”

Revelation 5:9 — And they sang a new song, saying, “Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its **seals**, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

Revelation 6:1 — Now I watched when the Lamb opened one of the seven **seals**, and I heard one of the four living creatures say with a voice like thunder, “Come!”

Revelation 6:3 — When he opened the second **seal**, I heard the second living creature say, “Come!”

Revelation 6:5 — When he opened the third **seal**, I heard the third living creature say, “Come!” And I looked, and behold, a black horse! And its rider had a pair of scales in his hand.

Revelation 6:7 — When he opened the fourth **seal**, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature say, “Come!”

Revelation 6:9 — When he opened the fifth **seal**, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne.

Revelation 6:12 — When he opened the sixth **seal**, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake, and the sun became black as sackcloth, the full moon became like blood,

Revelation 7:2-5 — Then I saw another angel ascending from the rising of the sun, with the **seal** of the living God, and he called with a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm earth and sea, saying, “Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have **sealed** the servants of our God on their foreheads.” And I heard the number of the **sealed**, 144,000, **sealed** from every tribe of the sons of Israel: 12,000 from the tribe of Judah were **sealed**, 12,000 from the tribe of Reuben, 12,000 from the tribe of Gad.

Revelation 7:8 — 12,000 from the tribe of Zebulun, 12,000 from the tribe of Joseph, 12,000 from the tribe of Benjamin were **sealed**.

Revelation 8:1 — When the Lamb opened the seventh **seal**, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.

Revelation 9:4 — They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any green plant or any tree, but only those people who do not have the **seal** of God on their foreheads.

Revelation 10:4 — And when the seven thunders had sounded, I was about to write, but I heard a voice from heaven saying, “**seal** up what the seven thunders have said, and do not write it down.”

Revelation 20:3 — And threw him into the pit, and shut it and **sealed** it over him, so that he might not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were ended. After that he must be released for a little while.

Revelation 22:10 — And he said to me, “Do not **seal** up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near.
